Latest Staff Training

On Tuesday the 22nd of August the Preschool Teachers and Educators had a 1:1 training with Paediatric Ear Nose and Throat Specialist David Macintosh to support our ongoing identification of children who may need intervention and increase our awareness on ways to refer. We are hoping to be able to share further information with you soon.

What are some of the signs and symptoms we look for? (It can be one, some or a combination of the below symptoms but not all). During the night does your child snore, sleep with their mouth open, grind their teeth, breathe heavily or stop breathing momentarily, walk or talk in their sleep, wake up crying or upset, toss and turn excessively, wet the bed? During the day does your child lose concentration easily, have behavioural or school work issues, need extra emotional support, have a blocked nose or hay fever symptoms, breath through their mouth, have audible breathing, appear tired or lethargic, have regular darkness under the eyes, choke on food, avoid eating or take a long time to eat/chew, have speech delays, headaches or bad breathe.

Does your child have Asthma, Sinusitis or Asthma?

This is the Lennox Head Cultural Story

As created by Aunty Sonja Brakenridge. You will see this on our staff shirts.

"In the middle of Lennox Head and the other meeting places in yellow and blue are the mob (people) who live in the town.

Our Ancestors walked this land before anyone. We came in different shaped feet and sizes.

The yellow sun is our mother earth, the connection between the God of Holy Dreaming Time and spirits and how the light surrounds us and keeps us grounded.

There's two mens bora rings. One is right where the school is built and the other is near the cricket ground (now known as Megan Crescent). This is where our men did Men's business.

Im not sure if there is any more

Near the football oval is a women's place out the back near where the mens bora ring is.

Then we have Lake Ainsworth where the three brothers landed and this is where the black people rocks are today.

One of the brothers Yarbirri thrust a spear into the sand and fresh water came out and this is the lake and it is said when low tide you can still see a rusty stain on the beach.

At lake Ainsworth down the northern end, this is where our Aboriginal Doodbay's (Women) gave birth to their children and put their babies in the Coolamons so they can sleep and carry them.

At the back of Lake Ainsworth is all the different bush and plants and scrubs.

The bream hole (known as the boat channel) is where our people would catch fish, the fish would get caught in the rocks and our people lived off pippies. These we think were the main source of food."

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
